## Craft: Unfolding Story Materials

Printout sheet (one page) Scissors Pens, pencils, or crayons

## Instructions

Colour in the pictures, then cut out the page on the black dashed lines.

Fold the paper in half horizontally and vertically with the pictures on the inside. Unfold after each fold. Fold the paper in half diagonally in both directions with the pictures on the outside. Unfold after each fold.

Turn the paper face down on the table. Fold each corner in to the middle point of the paper. Turn the paper over so that the pictures are facing up. Fold each corner in to the middle point of the paper again.

On the side with the words 'God gives Hannah a son,' put your fingers under the four flaps and push the corner points up and together so that the centre point pushes down. When you pinch the four points together the words should be in the same direction.

To go through the story, begin with the flap that says 'start here.' Read the words on the flap and then pull it up to see the picture. Move clockwise to see the rest of the story.
